The Antinori family have been producing wine in Tuscany for over six centuries, and exporting it for four, spanning twenty-seven generations of uninterrupted family ownership ...and counting.

The first recorded mention of the family dates from 1180, when they worked in the silk trade. Winemaking was added to the family's activities in 1385, and during the sixteenth century the wines spread, along with Antinori's reputation, to France, Flanders, Spain and North Africa.

The purchase of the Tignanello estate in the mid-1800s marked the beginning of a remarkable period of expansion, and since then, through judicious acquisition of vineyards and an uncanny knack for developing iconic wines, Antinori has become Tuscany's – arguably Italy's – pre-eminent wine producer.





Here at Buon Apps we pay close attention to provenance. All of the Antinori estates, new and old, have their roots in history and tradition. The love they express for the land is evident in the wine they produce.

## MARCHESE ANTINORI TENUTA MONTENISA Lombardy

Tenuta Montenisa estate is located in the heart of the Franciacorta production zone around the centuries-old hamlet of *Calino*. The union between the experience of the Antinori family and the characteristics of the terroir have given birth to the "Classics", a selection of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Blanc grapes, and the "Vintage" wines, a selection of the best Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes made only in exceptional vintages.

### SANTA CRISTINA Tuscany

The Antinori family released their first wine under the Santa Cristina name in 1946. Since then it has been a byword for quality in Tuscany – now more so than ever since the creation of a dedicated winery in 2006. The range now consists of reds and rosés from Tuscany and whites from Umbria, so the winery's location in *Cortona*, southern Tuscany, is ideal.

### VILLA ANTINORI Tuscany

Over the course of nearly a century of history, Villa Antinori has represented, and will continue to represent the concept of home, home territory and Tuscany in a contemporary style. Villa Antinori envisions wine production with experimentation and development on one side and historical values on the other.

### FATTORIA ALDOBRANDESCA Tuscany

The Fattoria Aldobrandesca estate is located in the southern part of *Tuscan Maremma*, in the centre of what is known as "the Etruscan Tuff zone". Vineyards grow on flat terrain of volcanic origin with tufaceous subsoils. Aleatico, a very old and traditional grape variety, and Malbec, a new variety for the Italian wine producing sector, thrive in this ideal terroir.

### PÈPPOLI Tuscany

This estate is located 5km north east of the Tenuta Tignanello estate and is home to Pèppoli Chianti Classico DOCG, a perfect expression Chianti Classico territory.

### TENUTA TIGNANELLO Tuscany

The Tenuta Tignanello estate is located in the heart of Chianti Classico, in the gently rolling hillsides between the Greve and Pesa valleys. Famous for the Tignanello and Solaia vineyards, two wines that have been defined by the international press as "among the most influential wines in the history of Italian viticulture".





### **JERMANN**

Friuli Venezia Giulia

A historic company founded in the 18th century, located in *Friuli Venezia Giulia*, one of the most renowned areas in Italy for the production of fine white wines. The Jermann winery best represents the quality and characteristics of Collio area, through the personality and the elegance of its wines.



### CASTELLO DELLA SALA

Umbria

A magnificent medieval manor. Famous for producing white varieties with one exception, Pinot Nero, which has found ideal conditions in this terroir.



### TENUTA GUADO AL TASSO

Tuscany

Tenuta Guado al Tasso is located in the prestigious *Bolgheri* DOC appellation, enclosed between the gentle hills of the Bolgheri amphitheater and the sea, on the upper coast of Maremma. This austere yet sweet territory, gives life to wines of great character, elegance and complexity.



### LE MORTELLE

Tuscany

Le Mortelle estate is in the heart of *Maremma* in Tuscany, near the town of Castiglione della Pescaia. The estate is nestled in the center of a small natural amphitheater, and features soils that tend to heat up easily. In this particular context, late varieties like Cabernet and Carménère are able to reach the maturity of the tannin expressing their full varietal potential.



### PIAN DELLE VIGNE

Tuscany

Pian delle Vigne is located six kilometers southwest of Montalcino in the prestigious *Brunello* wine producing region.

The philosophy of aging in large capacity barrels capable of preserving the clean, pure qualities of Sangiovese while imparting its characteristic vibrant elegance, gives Brunello Pian delle Vigne its extraordinary expression.



### **TORMARESCA**

Puglia

Tormaresca has two estates located in the best-known winegrowing regions: Masseria Maime in the *Salento* area and the Tenuta Carrubo estate in the Manduria DOC, a famous area for the production of its Primitivo grape. Character, personality and the potential for high quality are the characteristics that the Apulian territory imparts to all varieties grown here.



#### BRACCESCA

LA BRACCESCA
Tuscany

The southeastern corner of Tuscany between the cities of *Montepulciano* and *Cortona* is the birthplace of La Braccesca estate, an expression of the two very different natures of these territories: the tradition of Nobile from Montepulciano and the innovation

of Syrah from Cortona.



### TENUTA BOCCA DI LUPO

Puglia

The estate is located in the countryside of Minervino Murge in Apulia, the DOC region of *Castel del Monte*. The landscape is barren almost lunar, with soils which are low in nutrient, producing wines that are elegant, lively with well-defined aromatic precision and purity. Here, local grape varieties like Aglianico, Fiano, Moscato are cultivated together with international varieties like Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Chardonnay and Syrah.



### **PRUNOTTO**

Piedmonte

The Prunotto estate is located in *Alba*, the most important city in the *Langhe* area halfway between Barbaresco and Barolo, on gentle plains surrounded by vineyards in the Langhe and Roero territories, where great red wines are produced. Prunotto reveals its territory's rich heritage and unique attributes in each bottle of wine, capturing the thousands of different expressions that each vineyard parcel is able to reflect.

Antica and Haras de Pirque, embody the defining character of Antinori's innovative spirit, in the Americas.



#### ANTICA

Napa Valley, California, USA

The Antinori Napa Valley estate
was born from the dream and the
challenge of Marchese Piero Antinori
to create a sublime expression of Napa
Valley mountain terroir. The estate
rests within a hidden valley high up
in the Vaca Mountain Range, in the
southeast corner of Napa Valley.
The site is perfectly situated to create
complex, multi-layered wines
of elegance and poise.



### HARAS DE PIRQUE

Maipo Valley, Chile

Haras de Pirque is located in the easternmost part of the *Maipo Valley* in the foothills of the Andes. The horseshoe shaped, gravity-fed winery, is inspired by the estate's former fame as a thoroughbred breeding farm, founded in 1892. The unique climatic and geographic conditions of the Maipo Andes, are ideal. The harvest is done manually, so the grapes are in perfect condition to be immediately processed, maintaining all their quality.
